Activity Summary

- In this activity, students will: Survey vehicle attributes in school parking lot
 - Create bar graphs and pie charts based on results
 - Post **Essential Skills** related to activity (wall posting)



Choose one (1) of the *Essential Skills* you used in this activity and describe either in words or pictures some of the tasks you completed where that skill was demonstrated.


