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
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
This is Ben and Cathy. They live in Mexico. They live in a nice house. They work hard, but it's a good life.




They have six children. Danny is 9, Joel is 8 and Johnny is 5. Sara is 10, Maria is 7 and Katie is 3.




Sometimes Ben helps Cathy. He likes to help bake and cook. Sometimes Cathy helps Ben. She likes to drive the tractor.



The children help a lot. Danny, Joel and Sara help Dad. Maria, Johnny and Katie help Mom. Katie is not much help yet!




The children like to play. The girls have dolls. They love the dolls, but the dolls look very old!

The children go to bed. Mom and Dad sit up late. Mom gets the three dolls. Dad goes to work in his shop.




In the morning Katie says, "Where is my doll?" Mom says, "The dolls went away." Katie says, "I want my doll!"



Mom says, "If you are good, you can ask Santa." Katie says, "How many days til Christmas?" Mom says, "20 days."




Mom works when the children go to bed. She makes new dresses for the dolls. She makes the dolls look nice. Dad works in his shop.






It is time for bed.





Joel says, "Look at the horses! There is a white one, a black one, and a brown one."


Johnny says, "Let's go! Giddy up!"

The house is full of moms and dads and children! Grandma says, "It's time to eat!" There is a lot of food. It is very good. Dad says, "Oh! I ate too much!"




Mom says, "Children, go out to play." Grandma and the moms clean up. The men sit and talk.




Grandma calls the children in. She says, "It's time to sing. It's time to say your verses."




The children sing. They say the verses. Katie says a verse, too.
